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## Statement of Committee's Responsibilities

## Notes to the Financial Statements

### 1) Heritage Assets

Included within the Assets of the Club, are Cups and trophies, which under accounting conventions are considered to be Heritage Assets. For accounting purposes, these hold a neglible value.

### 2) Designated funds definitions:

Rescue Fund - to be used exclusively to pay towards the rescue of individual Golden Retrievers, not to be transferred into the general funds of any organisation.

Research Fund - to be used exclusively to support research into Golden Retriever health.

Elma Stonex Memorial Fund - to be used for 'the good of the breed', at the discretion of the GRC Executive Committee.

Working Reserve - to be used exclusively to support the working activities of the Club at the dsicretion of the Field Trial Secretary.
