A very happy, confident baby who immediately caught my eye with his positive attitude and constantly wagging tail. Once settled, he moved with a nice flowing action, showing good reach and

drive for his age. Mid-golden with a kind, appealing expression and excellent pigment. Presented a pleasingly balanced outline and stood on fabulous feet. A promising start to his show career.

**2nd – PUTJADE POPSTER** – Evan Mrs E & Mr M

Another happy puppy who enjoyed his day. Not quite as settled on the move as my winner, but enough to appreciate his sound construction and developing movement, still filling his frame. Kind expression and good overall balance. Tail would benefit from being trimmed shorter to the hock nonetheless another very promising puppy.

**3rd – XENOWEY STAY BEAUTIFUL** – Kiley Mrs J

**MINOR PUPPY DOG (3 entries, 1 absent)**

**1st – ASHBYGLEN TRUE COLOURS AT EMMABE** – Copley Miss E

Light golden puppy who moved with free-flowing, easy action and presented a very balanced outline throughout standing and moving. Happy and confident with an ever-wagging tail which flowed of a level topline. Excellent feet, good bone and a super expression with very good pigment. Showed himself well and I will watch his progress with interest.

**2nd – FENPINQUE ROYAL RASCAL BY MOLESTREAM** – Norris Mrs S

Paler boy with good bone and a pleasant, kind expression. Still maturing and not quite as settled on the move as my winner today, but a nice balanced puppy with free flowing movement and plenty of promise.

**1st – LYNSTE DREAM BOY (AI)** – Davies Mrs L

An eleven-month-old mid golden puppy with a such a lot to like. Good angulation fore and aft with a very balanced outline good length of neck, short coupled and plenty of bone. Super feet and a gorgeous, masculine yet kind expression and strong muzzle. Moved out well with style and drive, covering the ground with ease. A stunning puppy with a very bright future.

**JUNIOR DOG (7 entries, 0 absent)**

**1st – GOLDMARKER ALDERBARAN** – Smith Mr TB & Mrs LG

A super dog who presented a pleasing outline both standing and moving. Moved out well with purpose, holding a good tail set level with his back on the move. Neat feet, good second thigh and turn of stifle. Particularly liked his head with a kind, correct expression with good pigment. Sound dog of good breed type with balanced movement.

**2nd – BERRymeade LIGHT MY FIRE** – O’Gorman Mrs P & Mr S

A well-balanced, short-coupled dog with a rich mid golden coat. Kind expression and a happy, confident demeanour. Moved well, holding a level topline and in good strong muscular condition. Could easily push for top spot on another day; just preferred the overall finish of my winner today.

**3rd – LYNSTE DREAM BOY (AI)** – Davies Mrs L

## YEARLING DOG (12 entries, 4 absent)

### 1st – PUTJADE PITSTOP AT RIVERSCHARM (NAF) – Wedge Mrs L

A beautiful dark golden dog with a happy, biddable and charming demeanor. Masculine, well-chiselled head with a super expression and strong muzzle. Deep, well-sprung ribs, neat cat-like feet and balanced proportions throughout, giving a very pleasing outline. Still maturing and giving his handler a slightly hard time today but clear to see a quality youngster with much to admire.

### 2nd – DEWMIST DANZATORE WITH OUSEVALE JW (IMP SWE) – Clarke-Gear Mrs V

Cream dog with a soft, melting expression that appealed immediately. Good length of leg, giving him a balanced and elegant outline. Moved well, covering the ground with ease. Deep in chest with correct tail set and well-shaped feet. Pushed hard for top place.

Handsome golden male with balanced pleasing angulation and a correct lightly waved coat. Presented a balanced outline standing and on the move with a kind expression, short coupled with nothing overdone.

### 2nd – WYNRITA CALL ME ELDER PRINCE FOR HONEYMILL – Kinchella Mr P & Mrs T

Longer cast than my winner but still a dog of excellent type, well muscled and with a kind expression. Moved soundly holding his tail level with his back, but I preferred the overall balance and proportions of winner today.

## UNDERGRADUATE DOG (7 entries, 2 absent)

### 1st – ROCAMOKA HARBOUR LIGHT – Smith Mrs NJ

Presented a pleasing picture standing and moving. Nicely angulated with excellent pigment and covered the ground with ease, showing sound, efficient movement with good reach and drive.

Mid-golden male with a well presented wavy coat. Excellent pigment and a kind expression. Moved out well with good drive and was shown in fit, well-muscled condition which showed his balanced construction.

### 2nd – AMBERSUN SUMMER SON JW – Foreman Mr G & Mrs T

A very happy dog with a super front and rear assembly and pleasing outline, kind expression. Could easily change places on another day, but his movement was not quite as precise as my winner today.

**3rd - PUTJADE PITSTOP AT RIVERSCHARM (NAF) – Wedge Mrs L**

**POST GRADUATE DOG (4 entries, 1 absent)**

**1st – AMBERSUN I’LL FLY FOR YOU** – Foreman Mr G & Mrs T

Moved well once settled, showing good reach and drive. Presents a balanced outline with pleasing proportions, super feet. Lovely dark golden and well presented wavy coat, very appealing expression and well-angulated fore and aft with correct tail set which was held on the move.

**2nd - CINDERBANK MOVE IT JW** - Henson Mr K

Paler dog than my winner with a beautifully presented coat, he tended to carry his tail a little high on the move today. Balanced proportions with a kind expression standing on super feet, strong driving movement in good hard muscular condition.

**3rd - HARDYLLIC JACK OF DIAMONDS WITH KULAWAND** - Lane & Lane-Ridyard Mr RS & Mrs P

**OPEN DOG (9 entries, 0 absent)**

**1st – EVENINGHILL DETROIT RED** – Williams Mrs L

My star of the day. A mid-golden male of excellent size, balance and moderation. Short coupled with a pleasing outline, nothing overdone. Neat pasterns, super feet and well-made quarters enabled him to cover the ground with ease, showing effortless, true driving movement. Loved his kind masculine expression. Completely at one with his handler and a dog of real breed type and quality. Pleased to award him Best In Show.

**2nd - HAYDENGOLD JUST A RUMOUR AT SUNANDAIR JW** – Archer Miss P

Heavier in type than my winner but still a quality light golden dog. Well constructed with good substance, well-let-down hocks and sound movement. Just lacked the ease and overall flow of my winner today.

**3rd - AMBERSUN HEART AND SOUL** Foreman Mr G & Mrs T

**SPECIAL VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (9 years and over) (4 entries, 2 absent)**

**1st – CATNNELS INSIDE STORY FOR BRENSHAM SGWC VW** – Roper Mr I

This dog belies his age covered the ground with ease, holding a level topline and correct tail set. Pleasing and kind expression and moved soundly throughout. Would benefit from a little more thinning out on his neck and chest hair.

**2nd - EVENINGHILL MOMENT TO SHINE** - Harding & Start Mrs LJ & Miss R

Beautiful Expression on this bitch, movement not as precise as my winner today, maybe a little overweight as she rolled slightly on the move, Nicely angulated, short coupled and correct tail carriage. Could easily change places with my winner on another day.

**SPECIAL OPEN DOG OR BITCH (6 entries, 4 absent)**

**1st - ROSGAR DOLLY O’DARE AMONG MOSSBURN VW** - Pounds-Longhurst Mrs SH

What a happy bitch who moved out with purpose and drive coming and going, good balanced angulation, kind expression and beautiful feet.

Beautifully well presented and balanced pale blonde bitch with nothing overdone. Kind expression with good pigment, neat hocks and moved soundly. Could easily change places with my winner on another day, a lot to like.

## PUPPY BITCH (5 entries, 2 absent)

### 1st – CERRIMAR ELECTRA – Poile & Blackboro

Balanced mid-golden bitch with a straight front, good length of leg, correct feet and good angulation. Covered the ground well with positive, driving movement and showed herself confidently being at one with her handler.

### 2nd – MALTQUDOS VANITY FAYRE – Mandley Mrs V

## JUNIOR BITCH (9 entries, 3 absent)

### 1st – WYNRITA CALL ME MADAM – Leonard Mrs P

Although she left her best coat at home, she impressed me greatly with her excellent proportions and overall harmony and balance. Everything flowed together standing and on the move, excellent shoulders with a correct reach of neck. Kind expression, neat hocks and a good turn of stifle. A happy, confident bitch with real quality who well deserved Reserve Best in Show.

### 2nd – AMBERSUN WINTER TREASURE – Foreman Mr G & Mrs T

Another bitch I liked very much. Covered the ground with ease, showing sound movement and a gentle expression. Neat, cat-like feet and balanced construction.

### 3rd - WEISFORD BORN OF THE SEA TO CHINNORDALE - Maynard Mr RC & Mrs LJE

## YEARLING BITCH (3 entries, 1 absent)

### 1st – DEWMIST DOLCE VITA WITH CATNNELS (IMP SWE) JW - Wheeldon & Hurry Mr M & Miss K.

Super movement covering the ground with ease on her lovely cat like feet with good balance and good length of leg. Pale, feminine bitch with a lovely expression, with dark pigment and correct depth of muzzle. Good spring of rib and level topline with correct tail carriage. Went a little flat later on in the challenge, one to watch as I am sure destined to have a fabulous future.

**2nd - LOUELLABROOK LOVE STAR** - Brown Mrs AL & Mr ML. Well constructed cream bitch, longer in loin than my winner, neat feet with well let down hocks. Excellent shoulders with level topline. Moved out well with good reach and drive holding correct tail carriage on the move.

**NOVICE (11 entries, 3 absent, 1 withdrawn)**

**1st – WYNRITA CALL ME MADAM** – Leonard Mrs P

Consistently pleased me again here with her balance, sound movement and overall quality.

**2nd - ALTINDAN PERHAPS PERHAPS** - Taggart Mis AE. Moved Beautifully, covered ground with good reach and drive, apparently only her second ever show which she coped admirably with at five years of age. Dark pigment, nice straight front, good angulation.

**3rd - WEISFORD BORN OF THE SEA TO CHINNORDALE** - Maynard Mr RC & Mrs LJE

**UNDERGRADUATE BITCH (10 entries, 3 absent, 2 withdrawn)**

**1st – WYNRITA CALL ME MADAM** – Leonard Mrs P

**2nd – AMBERSUN WINTER TREASURE** – Foreman Mr G & Mrs T

**3rd - EVENGHILL HOME BY THE SEA** - Harding & Start Mrs LJ & Miss R

**GRADUATE BITCH (8 entries, 5 absent)**

**1st – MALTQUDOS ENCHANTED JW** - Mandley Mrs V

Very pretty bitch with a kind feminine expression. Moved well holding a level topline with correct tail set which flowed straight off her back whilst moving, good angulation fore and aft, good length of leg, well muscled. Lovely feet completed the picture.

**2nd - OUSEVALE OCEAN BREEZE AT BENROWAN** - Hush Mr & Mrs W. Pretty expression on this mid golden bitch with balanced angulation, short coupled, feet could be better, moved well with correct tail carriage.

**3rd - BERMARY SWEET CHILD OF MINE** - Staniland Mrs GP

**POST GRADUATE BITCH (9 entries, 5 absent)**

**1st – MOSSBURN GOLLY MISS MOLLY JW** - Pounds-Longhurst Mrs SH

Well-constructed bitch with good angulation and neat feet. Fabulous driving and flowing movement holding a level topline with correct tail carriage. Pigment could be stronger but did not detract from her overall quality.

**2nd - WYNRITA SMOKE’N MIRRORS** - Leonard Mrs P

Nicely balanced bitch, excellent pigment with a kind feminine expression, good reach of neck with good lay of shoulder, just preferred movement on my winner today.

**3rd - CHEEK TO CHEEK UNBRIDLED DREAMS FOR SIATHAM (IMP FRA) JW** - Falconer Mrs AE

## **OPEN BITCH (8 entries, 1 absent)**

### **1st – BENROWAN ESPRIT - Hush Mr & Mrs W**

Greying gracefully at eight years of age, enhancing her beautiful and kind expression. Moved out well, covering the ground with ease and showing a super flowing action. Level topline, neat feet and nothing overdone. A well-balanced, quality bitch, one that I have often admired ringside.

**2nd - GOLDMARKER LUMINESS (AI) - Smith Mr TB & Mrs LG.** A more angulated bitch than my winner but still balanced fore and aft with deep well sprung ribs, lovely pigment and kind expression, level topline held on the move, she had a beautifully presented coat.

**3rd - MOONSHINE DE RIA VELA OVER AMILONE (IMP ESP) JW - Turner Ms R**
